4. First aid measures

General Information:

If unconscious place in recovery position and seek medical advice.

Inhalation:

Remove from source of exposure. Get medical attention immediately.

Skin contact:

Immediately wash off with plenty of water. Take off all contaminated clothing immediately. Get medical attention.

Eye contact:

Wash off immediately with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

Ingestion:

Remove material from mouth. Immediately drink 1-2 glasses of water or milk. Get medical attention immediately.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide. Dry powder. Water spray jet. Fight larger fires with water spray jet or alcohol-resistant foam.

Special protective equipment for firefighters: As in any fire, wear self contained breathing apparatus and suitable protective clothing including gloves and eye/face protection.

6. Accidental release measures

Personal precautions: Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves and eye/face protection.

Environmental precautions: Do not allow to enter drainage system, surface or ground water. Dilute with plenty of water.

General protective and hygienic measures: Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Wash hands before breaks and at the end of workday. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Acute toxicity: This product has not been tested on animals but based on the toxicological classification the LD50 (oral) is estimated to be 200-2000 mg/kg. This value is of no practical significance due to the corrosive nature of the product.

Skin contact: Causes severe burns.

Eye contact: Causes severe or permanent damage.

Inhalation: Severe irritant, may cause respiratory tract irritation.

Ingestion: Causes severe burns. Ingestion will lead to a strong caustic effect on mouth and throat and to the danger of perforation of oesophagus and stomach.

Sensitization: No known effects.

CMR effects (carcinogenity, mutagenicity and toxicity for reproduction): No known effects.

Repeated dose toxicity: No known effects.
